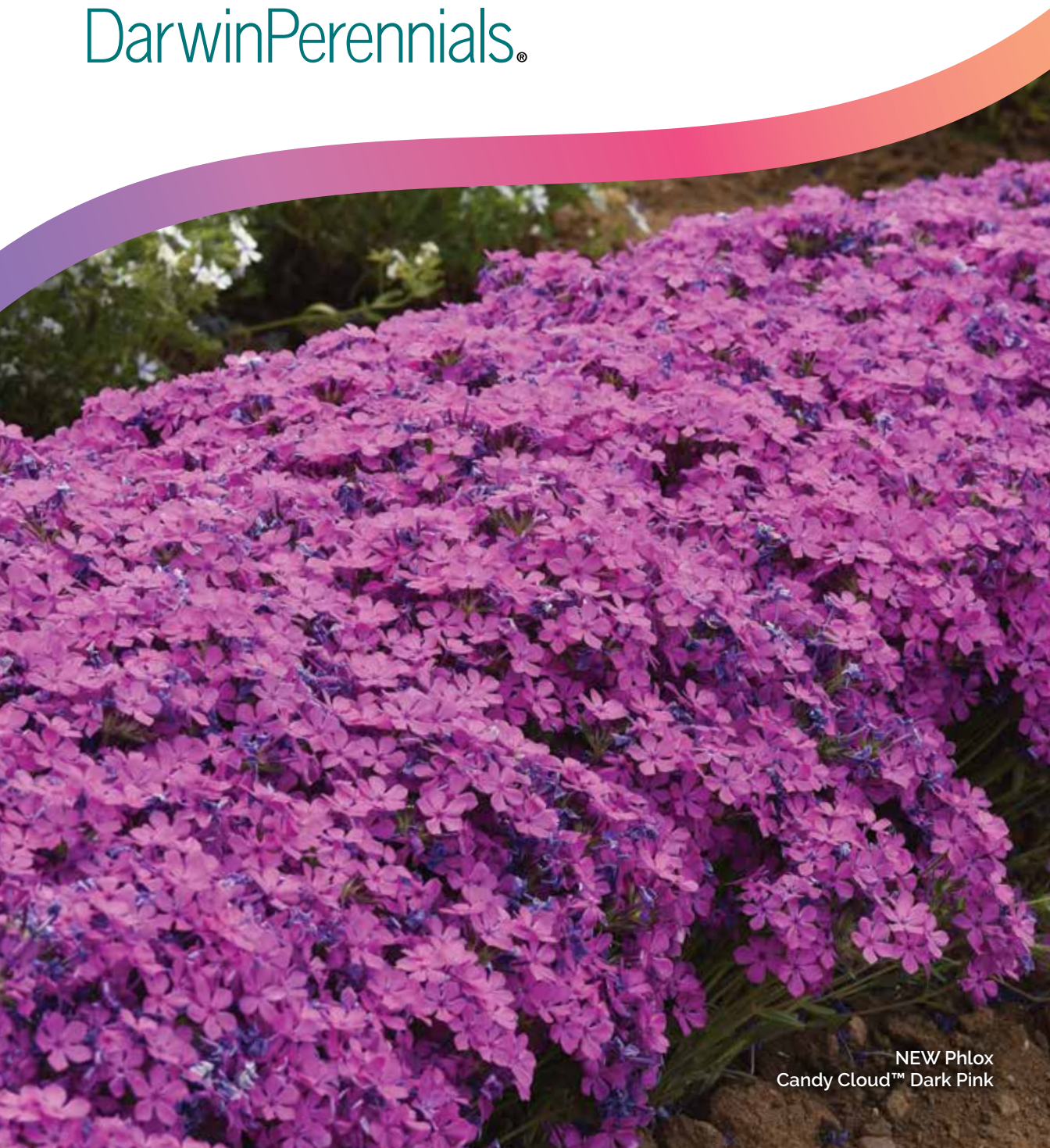

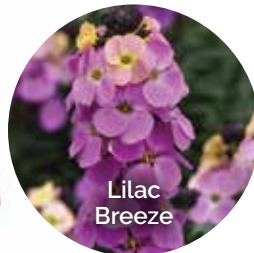

USDA Hardiness Zones: 5a to 8b



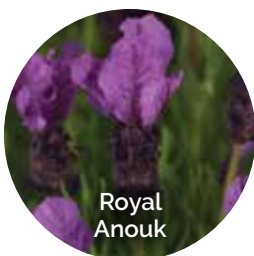
